Last Days of Pesach, April 25-27, 2019

Thursday, April 25th

Fourth day of Chol HaMoed / Erev Yom Tov

7:30 p.m.	Mincha (Afternoon) and Maariv (Evening) services; count the sixth day of the Omer Dvar Torah (before Maariv)
7:37	Candle Lighting; also light a flame to last until Friday night; count sixth day of the Omer

Friday, April 26th

First day of Yom Tov, Shvi'i Shel Pesach (Seventh Day of Pesach)

9:00 am	Shacharit (Morning) Service with song-filled Hallel
10	Torah Reading
10:45	Pre-Mussaf Shmooze followed by Mussaf (Additional) Service
11:30	Services end; no Kiddush at Aish
7:30 p.m.	Mincha (afternoon) and Maariv (evening) services
7:38	Candle Lighting for Shabbat and Yom Tov from an existing flame
After 8:39	Count seventh day of the Omer; repeat Shema

Saturday, April 27th

Shabbat / Second day of Yom Tov / End of Yom Tov

9 a.m.	Shacharit (Morning) Service with song-filled Hallel
10	Torah Reading
10:40	Yizkor (Memorial) Service (time is approximate)
11:00	Redemption Awaits: Mashiach and the Eighth Day of Passover Amanda Boltax (downstairs) Mussaf (Additional) Service (upstairs)
11:30	Looking Ahead: The Journey to Shavuot and Beyond Rabbi Hershel Lutch No Kiddush at Aish
7:25 p.m.	Mincha (Afternoon) Service followed by Dvar Torah
8:41	Maariv (Evening) Service; Havdallah for the end of Shabbat; count eighth day of the Omer
10:00	Permitted to eat Chametz that was sold over Pesach
